

2024 PGT PLO Series II

October 14-22, 2024



The **PGT PLO Series II** is a series of nine events with the player who earns the most PGT points awarded the \$10,000 PGT Passport. The top 40 eligible players as ranked by the PGT leaderboard at the end of the season will qualify for the season-ending **PGT Championship \$1,000,000 freeroll**.

General Rules & Information

- The PGT PLO Series \$10,000 PGT Passport bonus will be awarded by the PGT to the player that
 accumulates the most PGT points. PGT Passport can be used for PGT-owned and operated events and
 cannot be assigned, transferred, or withdrawn for cash. Players must cash in two events to be eligible.
 ARIA is not responsible for the administration of or calculations determining the championship bonus.
- 2. All events are 7-handed but will play 8-handed if necessary. Single table redraw at seven (7) players.
- 3. Late entries and re-entries will pay the full tournament fee.
- 4. Events #1-8 are two-day events, and both days start at the same time as listed above.
- 5. Events #1-3 will be 30-minute levels with a break every four levels while registration is open, and every three levels thereafter. Entry is open through to the start of Level 9 (~4:30 p.m.). There will be an added 1,500/2,500 level as level 4, and the 2,500/5,000 will be a double level.
- 6. Events #4-7 will be 40-minute levels with a break every three levels. Entry is open through to the start of Level 7 (~4:30 p.m.).
- 7. The \$25,000 Pot-Limit Omaha Championship will be 45-minute levels while registration is open, and then 60-minutes thereafter with breaks every two levels. Entry is open through to the start of Level 7 (~5:15 p.m.) and Day 1 will end after 12 levels.
- 8. Event #9 will be 25-minute levels with a break every four levels. Entry is open through to the start of Level 9 (~3:50 p.m.). This is a one-day event and will not be streamed on PokerGO.
- Events #1-7 will play down to the final six players or 1:30 a.m. PT. When heads-up play is reached, levels will be reduced to 30 minutes in Events #4-8.
- 10. Event #2 will see \$3,000 to the prize pool and \$2,000 towards progressive bounties.
- 11. Event #5 will see \$9,000 to the prize pool and \$6,000 towards progressive bounties.
- 12. Event #9 will see \$5,000 to the prize pool and \$2,000 towards bounties.
- All events are unlimited reentry except for the \$25,000 Pot-Limit Omaha Championship which will allow players a max of two reentries.
- 14. The PGT poker shot clock is 20 seconds preflop and 30 seconds postflop. Time extensions will be distributed according to entry point in the tournament; before first break (8), any point thereafter (6). Additional time extensions will be distributed for Progressive Bounty events, and to players in the money if the field exceeds 71 entrants (2) or 85 entrants (3). The final seven (7) players will receive six (6) additional time extensions.
- 15. Tournament Director has discretion to add or remove breaks.
- 16. Players must be 21 years of age to participate.
- 17. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- 18. Management reserves the right to change or cancel tournaments.
